SUBJECT OF CALL: Livestock Rotation

- Noted that current rangeland conditions partially hampered from recent drought conditions. Also, historic intense grazing resulted in erosion.
- Indicated that the Coronado currently uses rotational grazing system on all allotments in order to rest the pastures when necessary—part of an adaptive management system.
- Common scenario is a combination of rest and use, or even complete deferral for at least one full growing season
- Ensures that range conditions do not deteriorate
